



Frisky Dog General Information and Policies

The purpose of Frisky Dog Daycare is to provide a safe, fun and stimulating social environment. To ensure the safety and health of your pet and our other guests, we require all guests to comply with the following rules and regulations.

Age: All dogs must be 16 weeks or older.

Sex: All dogs must be spayed or neutered.

Shots: All dogs must have up-to-date vaccinations. Owners must submit written proof of DHLPP and Bordetella vaccinations. Rabies is required for puppies over 4 months of age.

Health: All dogs must be in good health. Owners will certify their dog(s) are in good health and have not been ill with a communicable condition in the last 30 days. Upon admission, all dogs must be free from any condition which could potentially jeopardize other guests. Dogs that have been ill with a communicable condition in the last 30 days will require veterinarian certification of health to be admitted or re-admitted.

Behavior: All dogs must be non-aggressive and not food or toy protective. Owners will certify their dogs have not harmed or shown any aggressive or threatening behavior towards any person or any other dog(s). Please remember your pet will be spending time with other pets and the safety and health of all animals is our main concern.

Application: All dogs must have a complete, up-to-date and approved application on file.

Enrollment Forms: All enrollment forms must be approved and on file before daycare can begin. Client must have credit card on file.
